Context

In February 2022, the Finance for Biodiversity Foundation launched a [position paper](#) (*Aligning financial flows with biodiversity goals and targets*) with suggestions for the draft Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF) in preparation of the 15th meeting of the UN Biodiversity Conference of the Parties (COP15). The position paper emphasizes that necessary actions need to be taken by all stakeholders, including the financial sector, to urgently halt and reverse biodiversity loss. The alignment of public and private financial flows is a policy aim for government action and for financial market actors. It is crucial to reduce negative impacts on biodiversity and incentivise positive impacts.

Goals

We have three goals for this side event:

1. Explain why the concept of alignment of financial flows is central to resource mobilization and mainstreaming of biodiversity in the economic sectors,
2. Discuss the idea that the alignment of financial flows is not only an implementing mechanism, but also needs to be a policy aim both for government action and for financial market actors,
3. Reflect on the suggestions for a clear definition and integration of the alignment of financial flows in the GBF goals and targets.
