1. Introduction

Syngenta Rückversicherung AG (Syngenta Rück), the captive reinsurance company of the Syngenta Group, has been a signatory of the UN Principles for Sustainable Insurance (PSI) since **January 7, 2026**.

As a regulated Swiss captive reinsurer, Syngenta Rück supports the Syngenta Group's risk management, resilience, and sustainability journey by embedding Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) factors into its underwriting, risk engineering, and governance frameworks.

This disclosure highlights our commitment to moving toward a more sustainable business orientation and supporting the Group's broader sustainability ambitions, including climate resilience and regenerative agriculture.

In alignment with the Syngenta Group's commitment to accelerating innovation to deliver solutions for farmers and the environment, Syngenta Rück is dedicated to implementing the PSI principles in a manner feasible for a captive company.

2. UN Principles for Sustainable Insurance

2.1 We will embed in our decision making environmental, social and governance issues relevant to our insurance business

As a captive reinsurer within Syngenta Group, we integrate ESG considerations through close collaboration with Group representatives on sustainability priorities. We actively support ESG-related risk management in business operations (including Natural Catastrophe exposure analysis, health and safety protection of our people etc.) and adopt the Group's ESG policies, aligning our operations with the broader sustainability strategy. This enables us to demonstrate our ESG journey to our stakeholders and identify synergies between insurance and ESG data.

2.2 We will work together with our clients and business partners to raise awareness of environmental, social and governance issues, manage risk, and develop solutions.

We maintain regular dialogue with all stakeholders, actively supporting the Group's integration of sustainability into daily operations. Through ongoing conversations with our suppliers (insurers), we address ESG topics collaboratively, recognizing their parallel commitment to sustainability. We work closely with insurance partners to discuss the benefits of managing

ESG issues and align expectations for ESG integration in our reinsurance arrangements, amplifying our collective impact on sustainability.

2.3 We will work together with governments, regulators and other key stakeholders to promote widespread action across society on environmental, social and governance issues.

We actively engage with regulatory and industry frameworks through regular participation in sustainability-focused events at FERMA (Federation of European Risk Management Associations) and SIRM (Swiss Institute of Risk Management). Furthermore, we maintain regular liaison with internal stakeholders – including but not limited to Health, Safety & Environment (HSE), Production and Supply (P&S), and Corporate Security - to enhance understanding and protection against ESG-related risks across diverse operational contexts and geographies. This involvement demonstrates our commitment to responsible management, sustainable development, and staying informed about evolving prudential policies and regulatory approaches to ESG risks.

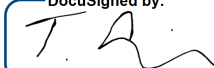
2.4 We will demonstrate accountability and transparency in regularly disclosing publicly our progress in implementing the principles.

We are committed to transparent reporting on our ESG progress through this PSI report, covering our first year of UN PSI membership, with annual updates planned thereafter. 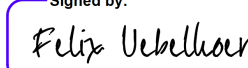
